Well, the rainy summer of 2017 is coming to an end and this means bowling season is just around the corner. I hope you have had an enjoyable summer.

Our tournament events are all set and you will find our 2017-18 schedule included in this package.

CHANGES FOR THIS SEASON

Our pricing has been reviewed by the Board and we have adjusted some of our membership fees down!!

The price for Unaffiliated has gone from \$190.00 to \$150.00. The extra money was used as prize money to our 2 Youth events but the board felt that it was becoming cost prohibitive to some so we have decided to reduce this membership category. It will affect the prize fund for our youth events, but we hope we can still manage this.

At our Tournament Players workshop in May 2017, the players asked that we have all players pay their National Assessment for their events up front. So many times towards the end of the season, players leave the Tournament Division for various reasons and the assessment is also lost. The Tournament Players asked and the board has agreed to have Tournament Division players pay their National Assessment completely by Jan 31st. Tournament Division tournament entry fees with therefore be reduced by \$20.00 since the National Assessment portion will have been prepaid.

The one exception to this is our New Years Classic Triples Event, where both divisions participate and so to avoid confusion and manage this one event easily the price for both division players at this event will remain the same as last year at \$155.00.

ALL EVENTS OPEN TO EVERY MASTER BOWLER. This season we will open up all events to everyone who is a member of our association and we have dropped the Hybrid fee. Many players have been playing "both sides" now for a number of years so this season, all events are available to members of our association with no "fill the field" restrictions. The exception is our "Seniors Division Only" members, who will not be eligible for other division aggregates unless they register as an Unaffiliated Member. Seniors Only are limited to 2 other MBAO events now plus the Master Senior and Special Olympics Events. There will be a criteria of events needed to qualify for Teaching and Tournament Division National Teams but if you wanted to participate in any event now or even be eligible for the Teaching and/or Tournament Division aggregate, you are now allowed to do this at no extra cost.

Master Bowlers who are on both Teaching and Tournament Aggregates must decide by April 30th which Year End event they choose to play.

Other information for this Season

SPECIAL OLYMPICS EVENT CONTINUES IN HAMILTON

Our 27th annual Ontario Special Olympics event this year will again be held in March, but our venue has moved to Hamilton Ontario. We were informed this month that Bowlerama West will be closing in January which has caused this change. 72 players are needed to make this a successful event. The date is set for Sunday March 18th at Sherwood Centre. It will be held only a couple of weeks ahead of the Ontario Open Championships so this is an opportunity to play on the same lanes and also to make the day special for our Special Olympic Athletes.

The day is important to the Special Olympic Athletes so I'm hoping you will join us and register early on our website. We need to be sure we have one member for each of the 72 Special Olympians who will participate. Entry forms are included with this package or please go online and register.

MEMBERSHIP REFERRAL PROGRAM CONTINUES

Our members referral program began last season and will continue this year. Any member who refers a new member or one who has been away from the association for at least 3 years, will have their referral noted and if the criteria is met, you can receive a \$25.00 credit off of next years renewal.

The referred member must be at least 25 years old, and must play in at least 24 games throughout the 2017-18 season in MBAO events. Seniors Division members must play in at least 15 games in MBAO events to meet the criteria.

Last year, 30 players were referred and joined the Master Bowlers Association of Ontario. Of these, 7 met the criteria and therefore \$25.00 credits will be issued to our members who made the referral.

Our website has the forms for new members and you simply sign your name as the person who referred these new members to our association and we will track things from there. Please remember the member must be at least 25 years old and are brand new to the association or returning after at least 3 years absence.

SHIRTS AVAILABLE ONLINE - COMING SOON

Affiliated Master Bowlers may now wear any MBAO Logo'd shirt and are not require to wear the Blue "Uniform" shirt as was passed at the 2015 Annual General Meeting. It is recommended as an Affiliated Member that you have your name and the name of your bowling centre on the shirt that you will wear at the Spring and Fall Master Youth Events. This helps to promote your bowling centre and is a form of appreciation for the centre who signs your renewal as an Affiliated Master.

We are working on a new Online Store where our members may order our shirts with our logo. The styles we offer and colours will all be listed as well as other items like towels, jackets etc.

We will continue to have a limited selection of shirts at our Tournament Events or orders can also be made at these events as well.

TOURNAMENT DIVISION AGGREGATE

For our Tournament Division this year, we have restructured the Aggregate requirements as per discussions and decisions made at last years Tournament Players Workshop. Our members decided to drop the Club Tour events from the aggregate requirements, however they did acknowledge that the majority of our players will still be participating in these two events. The England Family at NEBs run these events to promotion our game and we continue to help and partner with them on the Club Tour. MBAO Members may still register for the Club Tour through our website, however since these are not "official" MBAO events, the need to wear our uniform is no longer required. There will be no additional National Assessment fees at the club tour events. Also these events are now cash only, we will not be taking credit card entries.

We hope that all of our members consider playing in one or both of these events and that you will continue to strongly support the Club Tour at NEBs.

This season a Tournament Master must play in all 5 events we are offering. The Fall Classic, New Years Classic, Winter Classic, Spring Classic and the Year End event to be eligible to the National Team Aggregate. Tournament Division members are asked to pay their National Assessment fees completely by January 31st, 2018 (\$85.00 including HST). This fee may be paid with your renewal which would be our preference.

Our Henry Fehr Memorial Doubles and the Special Olympics Event is also open to Tournament Division players but will not count towards your aggregate.

I would like to welcome you back to the start of the 2017-2018 season of the Master Bowlers' Association of Ontario (MBAO), our 53rd season!

At the end of the 2016-2017 season, long serving Board member Elaine Freiday, as well as Bob Walters, and Barb Chapman chose not to continue on the Board of Directors. Elaine has indicated that she is willing to continue to help out running tournaments, if needed. The Board would like to thank Elaine, Bob, and Barb for the work they have done for the Association. Three members were elected at the AGM to the Board of Directors for 3-year terms and one for a 2-year as Jodie Barker resigned due to personal reasons. Neil Anderson, Cindy Toll, and Andrea Disher were elected for 3-year terms, while Tim O'Hara was elected for the 2-year term.

Similar to the previous year in which we had no motions or recommendations, this year we had only a few at the 2016 AGM. We thank the many members who still came out to vote for Board Members, the members who stood to run for the Board, and the members who came to share feedback with us about the 2016-2017 season. In addition, this past year we held a Teaching Players' workshop prior to the Saturday shift of the New Year's Classic. We received good feedback at this meeting, despite only have about a dozen members there. This year we will again have another meeting the Saturday before starting the Mixed Triples. This will be an opportunity for players to provide feedback to the association, in addition to the Zone meetings held after the Spring Master Youth Event. We are encouraging more members to attend in order to have their voice heard and contribute their ideas.

Once again this season, the elimination draw will be one of our largest fundraisers. We would like to encourage our members to help sell as many tickets as possible so that we can have another sold out draw. We continue to have great success with the Master Senior prize table. We will be running a similar table this year and if you have anything you would like to donate, please bring them to any event in which you are participating. Last year we started our "Chase the Ace" fundraiser. It has been very successful so far. Although it is unlikely to reach the same extent as the one in Newfoundland, ours begins the season at \$725. Tickets will be available at all of our Tournament, Teaching, Seniors tournaments, as well as Mid-Winter provincial round, Ontario Special Olympics Tournament, Provincial Master Youth events, as well as the Master Senior. 2017-2018 OFFICIAL MBAO DRESS CODE

The MBAO official dress code for all MBAO Tournament events during the current season will be as follows:

DRESS CODE (BOTTOM) APPLICABLE FOR ALL MASTER BOWLERS:

"BLACK" dress pants/shorts (for men) and "BLACK" dress pants/skirts/skorts/shorts/capris (for the ladies). "BLACK" dress shorts will be permitted at all MBAO events providing they are "golf length". Cotton pants/skirts/shorts/capris will be permitted provided they are not faded, have no rips, tears or studs on them and have no slits up the side of them. Jeans, harem, spandex, leggings, yoga pants, stirrups, sweatpants, cargo pants or warm-up pants of any kind are prohibited. No pants/slack/skirts/shorts/capris with external pockets on the sides will be accepted.

DRESS CODE - SHIRT (AFFILIATED MASTER BOWLERS):

All Master Bowlers affiliated with a bowling centre at all events involving youth (Fall and Spring Master Youth Events) will be required to wear the MBAO Shirt that has their name and the name of their current affiliated bowling centres on it. Shirts with Embroidery can be ordered through our Provincial Office using our shirt order form or it can be done by the player at their own expense. At all other events (optionals), players may wear this or any other MBAO logoed golf shirt. Any shirts with other provincial logos and/or national souvenir shirts are not approved attire.

DRESS CODE - SHIRT (UNAFFILIATED MASTERS AND SENIORS DIVISION):

All unaffiliated Master Bowlers will wear a MBAO logoed golf shirt. Golf shirts with other provincial logos and/or national souvenir shirts are not approved attire.

Members are not allowed to wear headphones of any kind for I-Pods, Walkman or other electronic entertainment devices on the approach during any MBAO Event. Medical devices such as hearing aids are allowed. Hats or other head wear, excluding those for religious purposes, are not allowed to be worn.

Any master found out-of-uniform may be given a written warning for a first offence and levied a fine of fifty dollars (\$50.00) for a second offence.

- c) If entering the Teaching Division as an Affiliated Teaching Master, I agree to play in the Fall Master Youth and Spring Master Youth events.
- d) That I will not issue a "Non Sufficient Funds" cheque to cover tournament entries and in the case of an "N.S.F" cheque, I must replace such cheque within 7 days of being notified and will pay a \$25.00 Service Charge for every NSF cheque written. All further payments to the end of the season must be by cash, certified cheque, credit card or money order. At that point, chequing privileges will be reinstated. A second offense will result in a permanent cash only basis.
- e) That I will observe all other MBAO rules pertaining to entry deadlines for each tournament and punctual arrival for tournaments, dress codes etc.
- f) Tournaments will start on time and late bowlers will suffer loss of frames already bowled up to the time they are ready to bowl.
- g) I will follow the MBAO Dress Code in all events or I may be assessed a \$50.00 Fine for being "Out of Uniform"
- h) I will not make derogatory or harmful comments about the MBAO, its members or any bowling organization or bowling establishment on any Social Networking website (i.e. but not restricted to Facebook, Twitter, Linkdin etc). Penalty for such comments could be immediate suspension from the Master Bowlers' Association of Ontario.

The Master Bowlers' Association of Ontario has established a "Perfect Game Pool" as an MBAO fundraiser. Any bowler who bowls a perfect game during the 2017-2018 season will be the recipient of 70% of the money in the "Perfect Game" pool.

As a fundraiser, the monies generated for the perfect game pool will be broken down as follows:

- a. MBAO Share: 30% of Total Raised
- b. "No Winner" Perfect Game Pool Carry-Over: 20% of Total Raised
- c. Annual Pay-Out: 50% of total raised during the 2017-2018 season for the Men's High Single and Ladies' High Single (amount calculated based on entries for Men and Ladies done separately).

Here's how it will work.

- 1. Each Master Bowler (Tournament, Teaching or Senior) will be allowed the opportunity to pay \$20.00 to enter the perfect game pool during the 2017-2018 season.
- 2. The perfect game entry will be accepted anytime during the 2017-2018 season and will cover the entrant for any perfect games and high singles bowled from the date the entry is received by the MBAO office or Tournament Staff until someone bowls a perfect game or the end of the current season.
- 3. The "Perfect Game Pool" will cover any sanctioned perfect games bowled during any MBAO tournament event. This will include the following:
 - a. <u>Tournament Division</u>: All games bowled during all compulsory tournaments including zone and provincial roll-offs for the Fall Master Youth and Spring Master Youth events (if applicable). This will not include CLUB TOUR Events for this season.
 - b. <u>Teaching Division</u>: All games bowled during all compulsory tournaments, all optional tournaments, all zone and provincial rolloffs for the Fall Master Youth and Spring Master Youth events.

MBAO Perfect Game Pool

- c. <u>Seniors Division</u>: All games bowled during the senior events, and Fall Master Youth and Spring Master Youth events (if applicable).
- d. Optional Open events like the Henry Fehr Memorial Doubles,
 MBAO Ontario Special Olympics Events.
- 4. The prize pool (consisting of the 20% Carry-Over and 50% Pay-Out) will be available to anyone (male or female) who bowls a perfect game, at any time, during MBAO events in the 2017-2018 bowling season. If a perfect game is bowled, the bowler will receive the appropriate value in the pool on that date. Naturally, if more than one 450 game is bowled during the same event, the pot will be split amongst those bowlers.
- 5. Once a perfect game is bowled, all members will be then notified and given the chance to re-enter the pool at the next event for another \$20.00 to start the prize pool over again.
- 6. If a perfect game is not bowled, 50% (fifty percent) of the pool will be split among the male and female entries for the men's high single and ladies' high single and 20% (twenty percent) of the money contributed during the 2017-2018 bowling season will be carried over to the following year's pool.

Example

Here is an example of the perfect game pool:

100 MBAO Members @ \$20.00 =		\$ 2,000.00
MBAO Share (30%) =	less	\$ 600.00
Perfect Game Carry-Over (20%)	less	\$ 400.00
Total 2017-2018 Pay-Out (50%) =		\$ 1,000.00

Any or all perfect game(s) would win or share \$1,000.00

If a perfect game is not bowled, let's assume our 100 entries are 65 men and 35 women.

Men's High Single

100 Total Entries of which 65 were male entries (65%) Pay-Out would be 65% of \$1,000 = \$650.00

Ladies' High Single

100 Total Entries of which 35 were female entries (35%) Pay-Out would be 35% of \$1,000 = \$350.00

As you can see, if a perfect game is not bowled, a carry-over of \$400.00 would be added to next year's Perfect Game Pool.

- 7. The high single (male and female) will be on a scratch basis only. Therefore, in MBAO events that use a pins-over-average format we will use the scratch scores for the male/female high single.
- 8. The perfect game must be a <u>"SANCTIONED"</u> perfect game. The criteria for a sanctioned perfect game is as follows:
 - a. The game must be rolled in a sanctioned MBAO event.
 - b. The Master Bowler must be a member in good standing with the O5PBA for the current bowling season. The member must have purchased an O5PBA membership card prior to rolling the perfect game.
 - c. All C5PBA rules must be followed.
 - d. The lanes must be certified in accordance with O5PBA certification policy.
 - e. The game must be reported through the local association to the O5PBA within 48 hours.
- 9. All pool money will be distributed to the winners prior to the end of MBAO fiscal year (July 31st). This will allow for a verification of all scores bowled by paid entries prior to this date.

<u>FORMAT</u>: Seventy-Two (72) teams (doubles) will bowl a four (4) game qualifying round. Teams will be listed in two formats, one with the Master Bowler bowling scratch and the Special Olympian bowling pinsover-average (POA), and the second listing teams on a POA basis only. Following the qualifying round, the top twenty (20) teams receive prize money using the following method:

- a. The top ten (10) teams listed in the Scratch Format and the top ten (10) teams listed in the POA format. Teams can only cash in one of either POA or Scratch and will be awarded the highest standing position after the qualifying round. EXAMPLE, if a team qualifies 5th place on the Scratch Leader Board and 7th on the POA Leader Board the team will be awarded 5th place prize money for the Scratch side and will not qualify on the POA side. Teams that are in the same position on both leader boards will be awarded the Scratch side of the event.
- b. The top (2) teams on the Scratch Side and the top two (2) teams on the POA side will play a one (1) game match. Scratch Side will play the Scratch/POA format while the POA side will play the POA format. Winners will advance to a one (1) game final match using the POA format for all players.
