PRESIDENT'S REPORT

The 2017-2018 season is the MBAO's 53rd Anniversary and we would like to take the opportunity to highlight some of the initiatives undertaken this season by your Board of Directors, as well as some ongoing projects.

Our membership overall this season is down a total of 31 members over last season. The continuing closure of bowling centres over the past few years, as well as the decline in Youth Bowlers appears to be the main reasons for this decline. Fortunately, some of the members affected by these closures and declining YBC programs are choosing to participate with the MBAO as unaffiliated Masters. We also saw new members join, which seems to be a reflection of the quality of tournaments we are running. We are maintaining these excellent programs and looking at new ways to keep encouraging new members to join.

Our MBAO Group Facebook page continues to evolve, and we are at 538 members now. We are using this page to post reminders of upcoming events, messages that we need to get out to our membership quickly, as well as to post initial results from our various events.

Jim Head and Andrea Disher continue in their roles of tournament director at our various events. We thank them for their service over the year in running our many events. Our Zone Delegates are an integral part of our association and each board member is linked with a Zone Delegate to support them as they bring our voice to the field. We pride ourselves that our events are run in a professional manner and this begins with the work of Dave in the office and continues with the various tournament staff we utilize throughout the season. Our programs would not be as strong without these individuals and we are grateful for their efforts on behalf of the MBAO.

Our Elimination Draw continues to be our largest fundraiser. In the 2016-2017 season, our elimination draw sold out for the fourth year in a row. This season, we hope to duplicate that success. We would like to take this time to thank all of our members for their support of this draw. We still have tickets left to sell, so if you can help sell some of these remaining tickets, please contact Dave at the office.

TREASURER'S REPORT

With the approval of the Board and Zone Delegates, I present the financial statement for the period ending July 31, 2017. The budget for 2017-18 is also included.

We incurred an operating loss of \$2714.99 for the fiscal year as a result of a banner year for milestone wins. Winners of a 5^{th} tournament receive a large diamond for their win. Our budget was for \$2500 in ring sales and expenses of \$5500. The actual revenue was \$3297.80 and expenses were \$9024.00 .

Our cost to attend the Nationals in Regina exceeded our budget because of an increase in the cost of air fare and hotel accommodations. The shortfall was recovered from our deferred National Assessment account in accordance with our financial plan.

There is a decrease in membership renewals this year, down by 31, however, we continue to receive new membership applications. This decrease in membership also impacts the number of entries we receive for our various tournaments and impacts the National Assessment we accumulate each year.

The Tournament and Finance committees are reviewing the fee structure for all tournaments, as lineage and other costs continue to rise. We must continue to sustain our National Assessment account for the remaining years in this cycle. 2018 in Thunder Bay, 2019 In Gatineau, 2020 in St Johns (Nfld), 2021 in Edmonton and 2022 in Winnipeg.

A big 'Thank You' to Dave Johnson, our Director of Operations for another year of excellent work.

A thank you to our membership for your continued support of our Association.

C4 CENTRE SENIOR TOUR REPORT

This tour celebrates its 25th Anniversary this year, and it remains a very strong component of the MBAO program. This season, C4Centre and proprietor/owners Judy Begley and Tim O'Hara continue with their sponsorship of this division. Their kind donations spread out over all 4 of our events have enhanced the prize funds for this tour. We thank Tim and Judy so much for their support to our Association and the Seniors Tour.

Also for 2017-18, our member Elaine Freiday has provided a sponsorship for our King and Queen of the Lane awards, through her company Freedom 55 Financial. For this additional sponsorship we sincerely thank Elaine for her support of this most popular division.

We set new participation levels this season so far with 80 players participating in our first event at Stellar Lanes and 78 players were competing at Event #2 at C4 Centre.

Bowlers can now join the Senior Tour the bowling season they turn 50 (can bowl the first 2 events if they turn 50 by Dec. 31st) and therefore, we hope to continue to add to our membership numbers, and allow these bowlers to qualify for the National Team.

Two years ago, we incorporated a "Team Event" as part of this Tour and the membership were very pleased with this new format. We will continue at our 3rd Seniors Event with this 4 Player Team POA Format to keep the Tournament events interesting and with variety.

The Senior MBAO ring, which is into its 11th year, continues to prove popular. It is distinctive in style, so as not to confuse it with the traditional MBAO ring awarded for victories in other MBAO events. In addition there are 2 sizes available to suit your taste and budget. A bowler winning an event may purchase a ring. When a bowler wins 2 events, 2 sapphires are added to the ring and a diamond is added for a 5th win. Victories prior to the introduction of the ring count toward the total. The ring has been well received and many bowlers have purchased rings.

In addition, all Senior Tour victories are now listed as part of the History of Tournament Winners document and also on a separate Senior Tour Victory document, as well as being combined with regular MBAO Tournament wins to show Total MBAO victories. These documents may be found on the MBAO website under Membership > MBAO History Information.

As usual, there will be a Senior Tour Workshop at the end of the 3rd event, and the results of this workshop will be available at the AGM. The C4Centre Seniors Tour continues to thrive. We would like to thank all the bowlers who participate on the Senior Tour for making it such an enjoyable and successful group to compete and spend time with.
