2017-2018 OFFICIAL MBAO DRESS CODE

The MBAO official dress code for all MBAO Tournament events during the 2017-18 season will be as follows:

DRESS CODE (BOTTOM) APPLICABLE FOR TEACHING/ TOURNAMENT/SENIORS:

"BLACK" dress pants/shorts (for men) and "BLACK" dress pants/skirts/skorts/shorts/capris (for the ladies). "BLACK" dress shorts will be permitted at all MBAO events providing they are "golf length". Cotton pants/skirts/shorts/capris will be permitted provided they are not faded, have no rips, tears or studs on them and have no slits up the side of them. Jeans, harem, spandex, leggings, yoga pants, stirrups, sweatpants, cargo pants or warm-up pants of any kind are prohibited. No pants/slack/skirts/shorts/capris with external pockets on the sides will be accepted.

DRESS CODE - SHIRT (AFFILIATED TEACHING/TOURNAMENT MASTERS):

All Master Bowlers affiliated with a bowling centre at all events involving youth (Fall and Spring Master Youth Events) will be required to wear the MBAO Shirt that has their name and the name of their current affiliated bowling centres on it. Shirts with Embroidery can be ordered through our Provincial Office using our shirt order form or it can be done by the player at their own expense. At all other events (optionals), players may wear this or any other MBAO logoed golf shirt. Any shirts with other provincial logos and/or national souvenir shirts are not approved attire.

DRESS CODE - SHIRT (UNAFFILIATED TEACHING/TOURNAMENT MASTERS):

All unaffiliated Master Bowlers will wear a MBAO logoed golf shirt. Golf shirts with other provincial logos and/or national souvenir shirts are not approved attire.

DRESS CODE - SHIRT (SENIORS DIVISION ONLY): All Master Bowlers will wear a MBAO logoed golf shirt. Golf shirts with other provincial logos and/or national souvenir shirts are not approved attire.

Members are not allowed to wear headphones of any kind for I-Pods, Walkman or other electronic entertainment devices on the approach during any MBAO Event. Medical devices such as hearing aids are allowed. Hats or other head wear, excluding those for religious purposes are not allowed to be worn.

Any master found out-of-uniform may be given a written warning for a first offence and levied a fine of fifty dollars (\$50.00) for a second offence.

Bowlers have the option of bowling Pins-Over-Average (POA), Scratch or both. Bowlers cannot compete in POA without a current MBAO or last year's average. At the completion of the four (4) events, one (1) National team will be determined to advance to the MBAC National Championships to be held in Hamilton, Ontario. The team includes the top male and female from scratch competition, the top male and female from POA competition and the wild card is determined by a rotation basis. As suggested at the Senior Tour Workshop and as passed by the Board of Directors, the Wild Card will be allocated to a woman every third year.

TOURNAMENT FORMAT: Open to all Master Bowlers and non members. Teams will be comprised of two (2) bowlers. Non members are allowed to play in this event however at least 1 member of the team must be a registered member of the Master Bowlers' Association of Ontario, Northern Ontario or Quebec. Players may pick their teams for entry. Teams will declare one (1) scratch player and one (1) POA player. Top eight (8) teams based on total pinfall +/- POA will advance to pay-off round. The play-off will be a four (4) game, team vs field format. Teams will be awarded points each game and ranked based on highest pinfall +/- POA. The team awarded the most points will be declared the winner.

DRESS CODE: The dress code for all Master Bowlers at this event will be the MBAO golf shirt and black dress pants and/or black skirts/skorts/capris for the ladies. The MBAO Official Uniform Shirt is optional and is also allowed. Non members are required to wear a golf or bowling shirt and dress pants. Please refer to our full dress code on page 5 for restrictions.

NON-Members: This event is open to Non-Members who wish to experience an MBAO tournament. If the non-member has formerly been a member of the Master Bowlers Association of Ontario in the previous 2 years, they will be given their former MBAO average for this event. If the non-member has been away for over 2 years, or was never a member of our association, all league average sheets from all previous year's leagues must be submitted and the MBAO will calculate an average from the year end averages for all leagues. This calculated average will then be blended into former member's averages or constitute the average to be used in this event for nonmembers who were never in the MBAO. League average sheets must have a minimum of 24 games played, not counting bowl off or declared scores. If no league average sheet is supplied, then the bowler will be assigned our default average of 215 for Ladies and 230 for Men. The average may be adjusted at the discretion of the MBAO Board of Directors.

2015-16 TEAM FORMATION: IT IS STRONGLY RECOMMENDED THAT ALL TEAMS SHALL CONSIST OF A MASTER BOWLER (AFFILIATED OR UNAFFILIATED) FROM THE SAME BOWLING CENTRE. IF THERE IS A SHORTAGE OF YBC SENIORS, THEN THE PROCESS FOR SELECTION WILL BE FROM ANOTHER BOWLING CENTRE WITHIN THE ZONE AND THEN IF NO ONE IS AVAILABLE/INTERESTED, FROM ANOTHER ZONE.

A six (6) game qualifying round using a "Scotch Doubles" format, that is, the Master Bowler and their YBC Senior partner bowl alternate frames. Following the qualifying round, teams by descending score, will be slotted into Scratch and Pins-Over-Average (POA) sections. Team standings after the qualifying round will determine if they compete in POA or Scratch categories based on their ranking in each. If a team is ranked higher in POA than Scratch they will compete in the POA single knock-out. Teams that tie in rankings will be paced in the Scratch category. Once the rankings have been done, the top thirty-two (32) POA and thirty-two (Scratch) teams will move to a single knock-out Match Play round until a winner is determined. Six (6) games per team are guaranteed.

Norah Oakley Trophy - Memorial

I didn't have the privilege of knowing Norah during her lifetime, recalled past MBAO Executive Director, Walter Heeney, so he spent a few moments recently in conversation with her close life-long friend Doris Luke. "She was a tremendous competitor" recalls Doris, "and whereas most people wait for things to happen, Norah went after her goals and persisted until she got them." As with a lot of bowlers, Norah excelled at many sports and it was basketball that first brought Norah and Doris together in 1939. Norah's maiden name was Beveridge and she married Don Culverson, who unfortunately got killed in World War II. Subsequently, she married Wilf Oakley. Championships became a way of life for Norah. She was a member in numerous Ontario and Canadian Ladies championship teams. Says Doris, "Norah won many local events and used to count on the 'Queen for a Day' tourney at Knob Hill for spending money." In the Masters, Norah won the singles competition at the Master Bantam event in 1966 and in 1968-69, won the aggregate title and traveled to Vancouver with Joe Chiki for the Canadian Championships. Both Norah and Joe were victorious. In recognition of her accomplishments, Norah was ranked 16th overall in the history of 5 pin bowling. The Master Bowlers' Association have decided to remember Norah, with a memorial trophy and have agreed, each year, to recognize the ladies' teaching division aggregate champion.

Orv Bauman Trophy - Memorial

On Wednesday, February 5, 1975 a tragic truck accident took Orv's life. His generosity, enthusiasm and love for life have been an inspiration to us all. Orv started bowling relatively late in life and once he saw the potential bowling offered for enjoyment he took full advantage. In 1964, he founded the Kitchener-Waterloo Association and was the first President. He spend endless hours building the association and fulfilled numerous functions, including lane certification, memberships, etc. and all at his own expense. In 1964, he was the driving force in staging the 5 pin bowling championships we are playing today, and followed it up by installing four lanes in the annex of the Kitchener Auditorium to host the Canadian Championships in fine style. Just imagine the amount of work involved in that project. As we know, Orv was an excellent bowler and a real student of the game. In 1961, he bowled a perfect game at Sportsman's Bowlerama in Guelph. In his travels, which were extensive, Orv would look for a local bowling centre and play the game housed there, whether 5 pin or 10 pin, duck pins or candlepins. A self made man, Orv loved bowling and will be missed not only in Kitchener, but across Canada. With the approval of Orv's wife. Adele, the Masters have inaugurated the Orv Bauman Memorial Trophy to be Presented to the aggregate winner of the men's teaching division. Orv worked with senior citizens and blind bowlers as an instructor and coach, and it is only fitting that this trophy assumes a place in our organization.
