# MBAO

Starting for the 2009-10 season, the Bill Boettger Bursary Tournament sponsored by Parkway Bowl will now be an event that is open to all YBC 5 Pin members (male and female) who are in their **last two (2) years of eligibility in the YBC Senior Division**. YBC Seniors must not be 19 years of age at December 31<sup>st</sup>, 2009. Entrants can compete on a Scratch basis or on a Pins-Over-Average (POA) basis. Each competitor will bowl eight (8) games to determine the 2010 YBC/MBAO Bursary Winners in each of four categories (Scratch and Pins-Over-Average, Male and Female). The prize is a one-year entry into the Master Bowlers' Association of Ontario (MBAO) as an affiliated Teaching Master.

Cost is \$40.00 per bowler.

Date: Saturday, May 15<sup>th</sup>, 2010 at 10:30 a.m. (Registration) and 11:00 a.m. (Start).  
Location: Parkway Bowl, 67 Ellesmere Road (Parkway Mall), Scarborough, ON.

The prize includes the MBAO Official Uniform Shirt, a MBAO Golf Shirt with 2010 Bursary Winner embroidered on the shirt, entry fees into the Master Junior and Master Bantam, Mid-Winter Blues, as well as the Year End and one optional event.

As mentioned all winners qualify for the MBAO's Teaching Division, however, if winners of the scratch component of the event wish to compete in the Tournament Division, they can do so at no extra cost if they meet the minimum average standards and will be entitled to the MBAO Official Uniform Shirt, a MBAO Golf Shirt with 2010 Bursary Winner embroidered on the shirt, entry fees into the Master Junior and Master Bantam, as well as entry fees for the other compulsory events on the Tour.

If a bowler wins the POA side and wishes to compete in the Tournament Division, and meets the minimum average requirements, the monies won to pay for the above Teaching Events can be put towards the Tournament Division. Other cash awards will be decided in each category depending on the number of entries.

If players choose to go unaffiliated as a Master, they will be required to pay an extra \$70.00 to join, as are all unaffiliated Teaching and Tournament Masters.

To be eligible to compete in the POA segment of the tournament, the bowler's average as of April 30<sup>th</sup>, 2010 must be provided by the roll off. A minimum of twenty-four (24) games must have been bowled and your YBC LEAGUE AVERAGE SHEET MUST ACCOMPANY THE ENTRY FORM.

**\*\*Bursary year must be taken within 4 years of winning it\*\***

### **\* \* \* GENERAL RULES \* \* \***

1. All Canadian 5 Pin Bowlers' Association Playing Rules (foul line, deadwood, etc.) will be in effect.
2. Smoking and the consumption of alcoholic beverages are prohibited for the duration of this tournament.

3. To be eligible to compete in the POA segment of the tournament, bowlers MUST be able to verify their average (individual record sheet, minimum of twenty-four (24) games) as at April 30<sup>th</sup>, 2010 at time of registration.
4. DRESS CODE:  
Competitors MUST be attired in an YBC identified bowling shirt \*. Hats, Caps or any other type of headgear, unless required for medical or religious reasons, will not be allowed.  
\* A YBC identified bowling shirt shall be any garment, regardless of style, make, fabric or colour that covers the upper portion of the body, providing one of the following graphics is screened or embroidered on the back, the front or the sleeve of the shirt and providing it is issued and /or approved by the bowling centre: THE OFFICIAL YBC LOGO — OR — THE NAME OF THE BOWLING CENTRE — OR — THE NAME and/or LETTER (NUMBER) OF THE ZONE.  
As well, one must wear black dress slacks/pants/shorts. Denim, track pants, corduroy, ruggers, cotton knit or harem type pants are not allowed. Ladies may wear black skirts/skorts/shorts.  
Bowlers who fail to adhere to this rules, will not be allowed to compete.
5. Should a bowler win both the Scratch and POA category, he/she will be declared Scratch Champion with the POA runner up being declared POA Champion.
6. In the event of a tie for any of the top positions, a one game roll-off will be held to determine the final standings.
7. All other prize winners involved in ties shall split the total designated prize fund affected by such ties.
8. In case of a dispute, the decision of the Tournament Director shall be final.
