Today's event is a three (3) game pins-over-average team event. The team accumulating the highest pins-over-average total will be declared the champions. In the case of a tie for 1st place, both teams will advance to the Provincial Championships. In the event of a tie for 2nd or 3rd place teams, the highest team POA in the last game will break the tie. Medals will be awarded to 1st, 2nd and 3rd place teams as well as high series flat, high single flat, high pins-over-average (POA) series and high pins-over-average (POA) single in both the Bantams and Juniors divisions. Only one medal can be won by any youth distributed in the above-mentioned order.

The winners of today's event will advance to the Provincial Finals being held on Saturday, March 11th, 2018 at Victoria Bowl in Kitchener, Ontario. At these championships, all teams will be competing in a three (3) game pins-over-average format. Complete details will be given to all winners today right after our awards presentations. Tournament winners should note, if you choose to stay overnight, you must book a hotel room within the next few days in order to receive the Tournament Rate. Our hotel booking deadline is February 10th, 2018.

The Master and YBC Players will bowl all three (3) games together as a team. Teams will have your Bantam bowlers bowling as the first player on the team, followed by the Junior bowler and then the

Master Bowler. In the teams comprised with two (2) Bantams and/or two (2) Juniors, the YBC Bowlers will bowl first and then the Master Bowler in the order that appears on your lane sheet. Again remember that this is a POA event and therefore everyone has an equal chance to win.

All Canadian 5 pin rules will be in effect. Foul line and deadwood will be observed. Please follow the lane schedule and move to the next set of lanes as I have recorded on your Lane Sheets. No food or drinks in the playing area and the spectators are asked to stay out of the playing area to let the bowlers compete on their own.

** NOTE **

The averages shown for the Master Bowlers are based on the previous four (4) years aggregate scores plus events from this season. This information is stored in our database and updated prior to each event.

Our Elimination Draw fundraiser this season have been enhanced, providing cash awards for every 25 tickets sold and the final ticket drawn will be worth at least \$1500.00 to the lucky winner. Tickets cost \$20.00 and you can come to see me if you would like to purchase one. They are available to parents, spectators and Master Bowlers and will sell out very soon. Last years top two prizes were \$1000.00 and \$2000.00.

We want to remind you of the upcoming Orleans Eastern Ontario Teaching Event. This event is scheduled for April 14th and 15th, 2018 at Orleans Bowling Centre, Orleans, Ontario who are also sponsoring this event which will enhance our prize fund. There are two shifts available and again, we hope if you plan to attend, that you will register online on our Website soon.
